The alarms are all motion sensors. The system arms automatically at 1130pm. A person would have to be very still to not set them off after the system is armed. So it is conceivable that a sleeping person would not move all night.

I have also attached a panoramic photo of the room. You can see that it is set up more as an office and for small groups.

This is the text from an email response from one of our staff members:

He's been in here off and on (mostly on Mondays) for the last couple of months; however last week beginning on Monday morning, he was in here from the time I came in at 8:00 am and was still here when I left at 2:30. I always locked the door before I left and told him the door would be locked. He used the computer at Kellie Morehouse's desk and his cell phone. He used our copy machine, the printer. It sounded like he was working on the Cesar Chavez event at UCD. If I could be totally honest...there were some phone calls that were kind of border line angry. He was quite irritated with someone touching his mail and it appeared that he was upset with some vendors. I hope this helps.

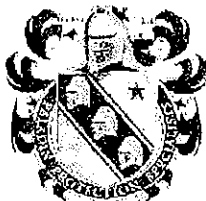
